- 2. I am informed of the benefits, risks, side effects, and alternatives to planned services;
- 3. I will receive communication from the school counselor if my student(s) will receive ongoing or one on one counseling support.
- 4. I understand that I can deny services if I choose too.
- 5. I understand that records are confidential and are not released unless St Elizabeth's is legally obligated to release information due to a court order, event of medical emergency, report of child abuse or neglect, or imminent risk of harm.
